



FlexCité has won the DPT contract for the Val d'Oise area

On September 15th 2010, the council of the Val d'Oise department entrusted FlexCité with the management and operation of its new Disabled Persons Transport (DPT) services for a period of 5 years.

Subsidised by the STIF, the Ile-de-France Region and the Val d'Oise department, this new on-demand transport service is provided every day of the year except for May 1st. 65,000 trips are anticipated for 2011. Besides door-to-door transport (PAM 95), FlexCité has also been entrusted with transporting disabled persons to medico-social services. With all the know-how and experience it has acquired in other "departments" (PAM 78 until 2010, PAM 77, 91, 93 and 94), FlexCité has succeeded in winning the Val d'Oise council's confidence by offering a quality service that is always ready to listen to its users.

With this new contract, which comes into force on January 11th 2011, FlexCité has increased its presence in the Ile-de-France region.
