

RATP Group wins contract for operation of Paris-Saclay municipal federation bus network

RATP Group is proud to have been entrusted with the operation of the Plateau de Saclay's public transportation network—spanning the territory of the Paris-Saclay municipal federation and serving nearly 300,000 residents—for the next 6 years. This new success demonstrates the confidence Île-de-France Mobilités has in the ability of the RATP Group to offer adapted transport services that meet the developmental priorities of the Paris-Saclay area.

Expertise to address future mobility needs

Very active and rapidly expanding network

The bustling Plateau de Saclay bus network is used by nearly 300,000 residents for their daily trips.

Between 2016 and 2020, service offerings and usage expanded nearly 20%. Over the next years, usage is expected to continue climbing sharply. The RATP Group must support this vigorous growth while substantially improving on-time performance for the 44 regular and 2 demand-responsive bus lines.

Starting 1 August 2022, it will operate 20 vehicles and a bus depot in Marcoussis, and it will be building a second depot in Villebon. The contract also covers management and maintenance of 13.5 km of the dedicated route linking Massy to the Plateau de Saclay via the Polytechnique district in Palaiseau.
